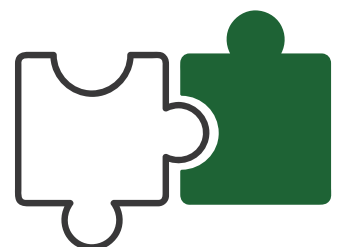

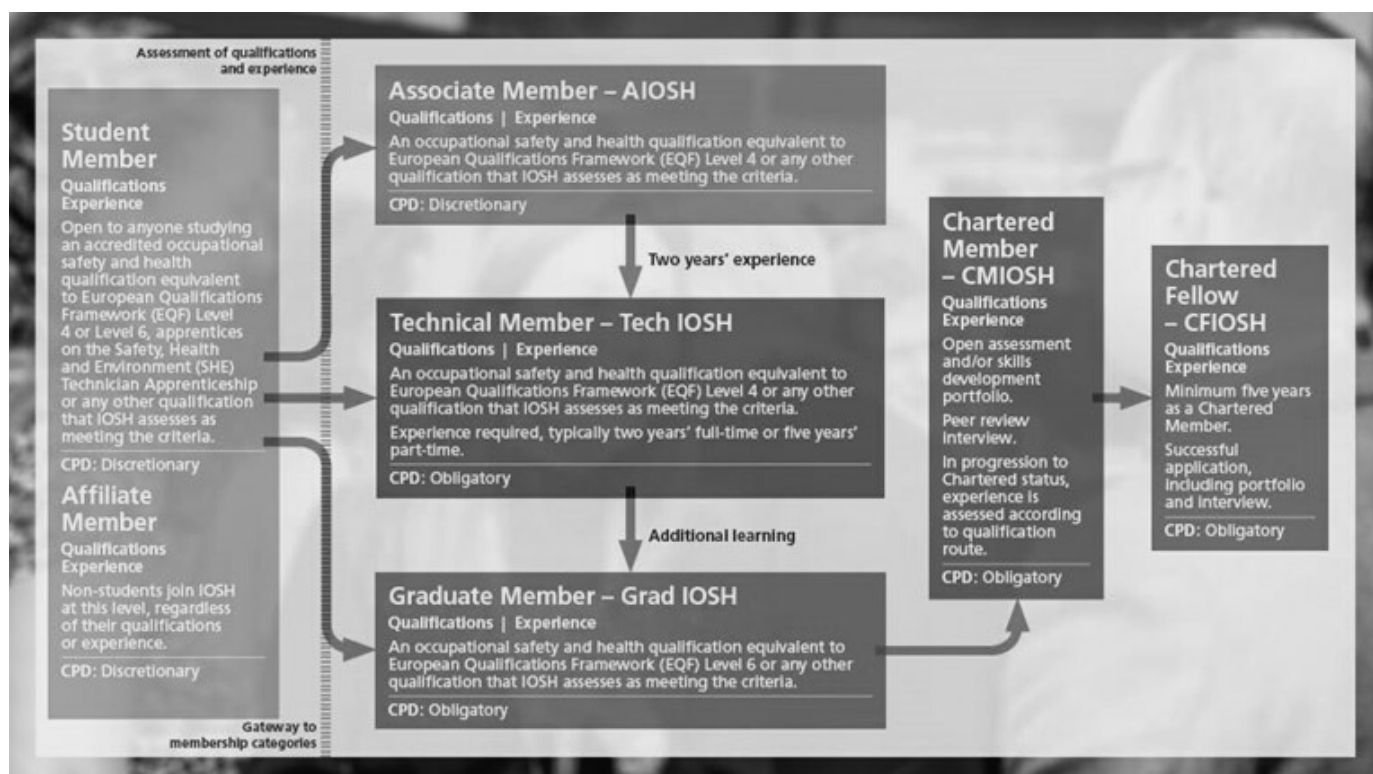

Level 3 Award in Delivering Training (RQF)

Overview

The objective of this qualification is to support a role in the workplace. It is a practical qualification suitable for new and experienced trainers (external and internal) who wish to improve their classroom skills and obtain a training qualification, which will also enable them to deliver regulated qualifications.

This qualification provides a good basis to help learners get a 'foot first' into training. The focus is on the effective delivery of training, allowing learners to develop planning, preparation and delivery skills, including delivery methods, questioning techniques and time management.

It's mainly aimed at those who will use pre-prepared training materials to deliver training within the workplace, as opposed to a training qualification that is more focused on procedures, protocol and regulatory requirements, such as education and training.

How long will it take me to achieve this qualification?

The total qualification time for this qualification is **15 hours** and of this **12** are recommended as guided learning hours.

How is the qualification assessed?

This qualification is assessed by a practical assessment and a self-evaluation report. Learners must practically demonstrate the delivery of either 1 or 2 micro teaching session(s) totaling 20 to 30 minutes, which demonstrates suitable level of achievement against each assessment criteria. Learners must also produce a simple timed plan, which should accompany the assessment pack. The self-evaluation report should be written by the learner and be submitted with the assessment pack.

COSHH - Level 2 Award in the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health

Who is this qualification for?

This qualification is aimed at individuals who work in an environment where coming into contact with hazardous substances is likely. This includes workplaces in areas such as manufacturing, cleaning, healthcare, transport, utilities and office environments.

How long will it take?

To complete this qualification learners should expect to undertake 5 hours of guided learning.

Topics covered

These include the law relating to hazardous substances in the workplace, how risk assessments contribute to the safe use of hazardous substances in the workplace and the precautions and procedures necessary to ensure that risks associated with hazardous substances are properly controlled.

Assessment method

This qualification is assessed by a multiple-choice examination.

Level 2 Award in the Principles of Fire Safety (RQF)

Who is this qualification for?

This qualification is aimed at anyone involved in the management of fire safety in any workplace. This includes managers, supervisors, team leaders, fire wardens (marshals) and staff working in any area where there is a potential risk of fire. Learners gaining this qualification will know that fire safety is the responsibility of everyone in the workplace and will recognise the consequences of fire in any premises.

How long will it take?

To complete this qualification, learners should expect to undertake 6 hours of guided learning.

Topics covered

These include hazards and risks, the control of fire risk, principles and practice of fire safety management at work and the role of the nominated fire warden.

Assessment method

This qualification is assessed by a multiple-choice examination.

Award in First Aid at Work at SCQF Level 6

Who is this qualification for?

This qualification is aimed at learners who wish to become first-aiders in the workplace. This qualification meets the requirements for training first-aiders in those organizations that have identified that staff needs to be trained to this level within their first-aid needs assessment.

How long will it take?

To complete these qualification learners should expect to undertake 22 hours of learning, typically over three days, with a minimum contact time of 18 hours.

Topics covered

The qualification covers knowledge such as the roles and responsibilities of the first aider, how to assess an incident and recognizing signs and symptoms of injury and illness. The qualification also covers first aid skills in CPR and use of an AED and assisting a casualty who is suffering from major injury and illness such as chest injuries, spinal injuries and anaphylaxis.

Assessment method

This qualification is assessed by a practical demonstration and a multiple-choice theory test.

Level 3 Award in Emergency First Aid at Work

Who is this qualification for?

This qualification is aimed at learners who wish to become emergency first-aiders in the workplace. This qualification meets the requirements for training emergency first-aiders in those organizations that have identified that staffs need to be trained to this level within their first-aid needs assessment.

How long will it take?

To complete this emergency first aid at work qualification learners should expect to undertake 7 hours of learning, typically over one day, with a minimum contact time of 6 hours.

Topics covered

The qualification covers knowledge such as the roles and responsibilities of the first aider and how to assess an incident. The qualification also covers first aid skills in CPR and use of an AED, providing first aid to a casualty who is choking and dealing with external bleeding and hypovolemic shock.

Assessment method

This qualification is assessed by a practical demonstration and a multiple-choice theory test.

Level 3 Award in First Aid at Work

Who is this qualification for?

This qualification is aimed at learners who wish to become first-aiders in the workplace. This qualification meets the requirements for training first-aiders in those organizations that have identified that staffs need to be trained to this level within their first-aid needs assessment.

How long will it take?

To complete these qualification learners should expect to undertake 22 hours of learning, typically over three days, with a minimum contact time of 18 hours.

Topics covered

The qualification covers knowledge such as the roles and responsibilities of the first aider, how to assess an incident and recognizing signs and symptoms of injury and illness. The qualification also covers first aid skills in CPR and use of an AED and assisting a casualty who is suffering from major injury and illness such as chest injuries, spinal injuries and anaphylaxis.

Assessment method

This qualification is assessed by a practical demonstration and a multiple-choice theory test.

Level 2 Award in HACCP for Catering

Who is this qualification for?

The Highfield Level 2 Award in HACCP for Catering (RQF) is aimed at those working in a food catering environment and other food handlers. The qualification is intended for those already working in HACCP catering teams and those who are preparing to work in the industry.

How long will it take?

The total qualification time (TQT) for this qualification is 7 hours and of this, 6 hours are recommended as guided learning hours (GLH). This qualification is usually delivered over 1 day.

Topics covered

These include knowing the procedures required to develop food safety management systems based on HACCP principles and also how to develop these systems based on HACCP principles.

Assessment method

This qualification is assessed by a multiple-choice examination.

Level 3 Award in Food Safety for Catering

Who is this qualification for?

This qualification is aimed at those working in the catering industry who are at, or wish to progress to, a higher or supervisory level.

How long will it take?

To complete this qualification learners should expect to undertake a minimum of 20 hours of learning.

Topics covered

These include ensuring compliance with food safety legislation, the application and monitoring of good hygiene practice, how to implement food safety management procedures and the application and monitoring of good practice regarding contamination, microbiology and temperature control.

Assessment method

This qualification is assessed by a multiple-choice examination.

MEDIC FIRST AID BASIC PLUS CPR, AED AND FIRST AID FOR ADULTS

MEDIC First Aid® Basic Plus is a combined adult CPR, AED and first aid training program designed specifically for the occupational first aid provider. This extremely flexible program will help employers meet OSHA and other federal and state regulatory requirements for training employees how to respond and care for medical emergencies at work.

Recognized certification period

- Up to 2 years

Successful completion (certification)

- Written evaluation: Required when specified by organizational, local, or state regulation.
- Performance evaluation: All students must perform required skills competently without assistance.

Recommended time to complete

- Initial training: 4–5 hours
- Renewal training: Less than initial instructional time

ADVANCED CARDIAC LIFE SUPPORT (ACLS)

The American Safety & Health Institute Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ASHI ACLS) program is a scenario (case-based) continuing education course intended for trained and skilled healthcare providers who either direct or participate in cardiopulmonary emergencies and resuscitation efforts. The course is designed to provide students with an opportunity to enhance and refine knowledge and hands-on skill proficiency in emergency cardiovascular care.

Certification period

May not exceed 2 years from month of issue.

Successful completion (certification)

- Written evaluation: Successful completion requires a correct score of 75% or better.
- Performance evaluation: Students must successfully complete a performance evaluation of the following:

-High-quality BLS (CPR/AED)

-Respiratory arrest – Cardiac rhythm management including pulseless VT/VF and 2 other rhythms

Recommended time to complete

- Initial training: About 15 hours
- Renewal training: About 7 hours

BASIC LIFE SUPPORT (BLS)

Basic Life Support program helps keep healthcare professionals prepared and ready to respond as they encounter life-threatening emergencies, provide basic life support and respond to choking incidents. ASHI's Basic Life Support, BLS for Healthcare Providers and Professional Rescuers conforms to the 2015 AHA Guidelines Update for CPR and ECC. It has been approved for training for Emergency Medical Services personnel and is accepted by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT). The program is also CAPCE approved and widely accepted in more than 150 healthcare-related occupations.

Recognized certification period

- Up to 2 years

Successful completion

(certification)

- Written evaluation: Successful completion requires a correct score of 70% or better
- Performance evaluation: All students must perform required skills competently without assistance: External chest compression for adults, children and infants; Rescue breaths using a CPR mask; Rescue breaths using a bag-mask device; Primary assessment for an unresponsive patient; CPR as a single provider for adults, children and infants; Safely attach and operate an automated external defibrillator (AED); CPR as part of a team of two or more providers.

Recommended time to complete

- Initial training: 4-5 hours
- Renewal training: Less than initial instructional time

1 IADC Rig pass

IADC's Rig Pass® program

(including SafeLandUSA and Safe Gulf endorsements) is an accreditation system delivering a standardized safety orientation program for new employees, preparing the employees for almost any operating environment, at almost any site, onshore or offshore.

IADC Rig Pass® accreditation is open to all drilling and ancillary service contractors, commercial providers, and educational institutions and agencies.

Operators and contractors may be confident in the knowledge that every program is subject to review and evaluation by independent parties. Site visits and maintenance of an audit history are key parts of the IADC Rig Pass® system.

2 IADC – Well Sharp - Introductory Level Well Control – 2 Days (JV)

Overview:

This IADC Well Sharp introductory well control course will teach attendees basic well control fundamentals, practices and procedures for surface and subsea stack through our Total Quality Assurance approach. It is intended for rig crewmembers that are new hires.

IADC Well Sharp Driller Level Well Control – 5 days (JV)

Overview:

The IADC Well Sharp Driller Level Well Control course is essential training for those currently working in a role that is expected to shut-in a well. The course aims to reinforce and improve the candidate's existing knowledge and appreciation of the various stages of shutting-in a well; from kick detection to shutting in the well, to monitoring once the well is shut in and monitoring the well-kill operation.

Course Delivery

The course is delivered over **5 days** through presentation of a series of interactive lectures supported by videos and animations, supplemented by a classroom workbook and further self-study exercises and practical work on a drilling simulator.

Under the Well Sharp programme and unlike IWCF training, IADC Driller Level candidates are taught completely separately from IADC Supervisor Level candidates and will not be in a mixed class. The course ends with an online assessment on the final day which will be administered by IADC and invigilated by an independent proctor.

IADC Well Sharp Supervisor Level Well Control – 5 Days (JV)

Overview:

The IADC Well Sharp Supervisor Level Well Control course is essential training for those working in well site supervisory roles and for office-based personnel that are primarily involved in the operational decision-making process and/or well design. The course aims to build on the Driller Level course content (including kick detection and shut-in) and focus on more complex aspects of well control and well kill methodology.

Course Delivery:

The course is delivered over **5 days** through presentation of a series of interactive lectures supported by videos and animations, supplemented by a classroom workbook and further self-study exercises and practical work on a drilling simulator.

Under the Well Sharp programme and unlike IWCF training, IADC Supervisor Level candidates are taught completely separately from IADC Driller Level candidates and will not be in a mixed class. The course ends with an online assessment on the final day which will be administered by IADC and invigilated by an independent proctor.

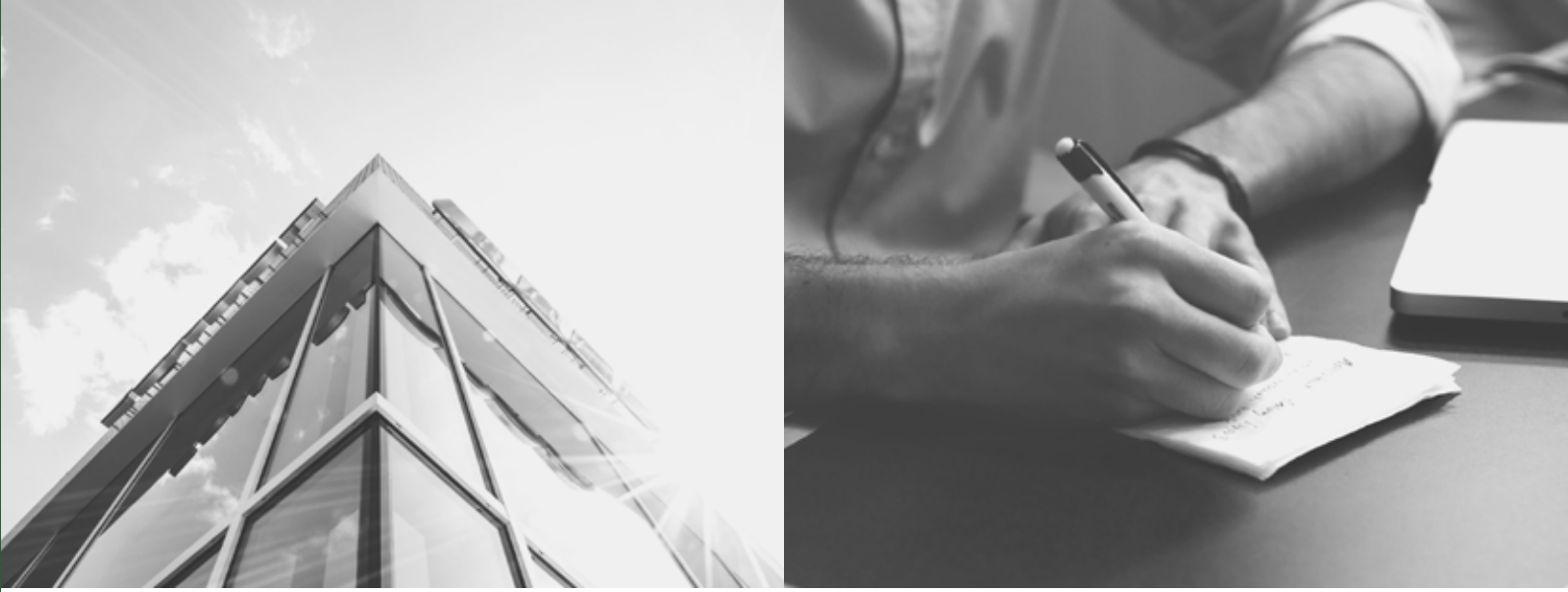
